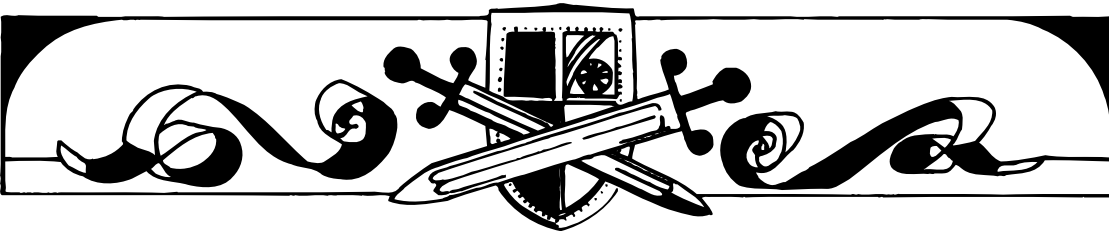


# Gideon's Army

In the Book of Judges (chapters 6, 7, 8) is the story of Gideon and how he won a battle over the enemies of Israel. Read the story and fill in the blanks below. Then in the big picture find little pictures of the words you have filled in.

There were so many enemies that they seemed to be like grasshoppers in the valley. They had so many camels that the Israelites couldn't begin to count them. God told Gideon to use only three hundred men to fight that large army. Gideon chose his men by watching how they drank water from the stream. Every man who lapped water like a dog was chosen to be one of Gideon's men. Their weapons were a trumpet, an empty pitcher, and a lamp (torch). All the soldiers were told to shout, "The sword of the Lord and Gideon." God was with Gideon and his men. The Israelites won the battle. (KJV)
